

**Wairau Intermediate School (1555)**  
**DRAFT Enrolment Scheme**  
Effective from (January 2020)

The guidelines for development and operation of enrolment schemes are issued under section 11G (3) of the Education Act 1989 for the purpose of describing the basis on which the Secretary's powers in relation to enrolment schemes will be exercised.

**Home Zone**

**All students who live within the home zone described below and/or shown on the attached map shall be entitled to enrol at the school.**

**The Wairau Intermediate School Home Zone:**

*Starting at the intersection of the Upper Harbour Highway (SH18) off ramp and Constellation Drive travel east along Constellation Drive (Holder Place included, Apollo Drive and Centorian Drive Excluded) to East Coast Road. Travel south east along East Coast Road (32-446, 33-327 addresses included, Galaxy Drive and Matipo Road Excluded) before travelling east along Kowhai Road (Beach Road addresses 1-387 and 2-330 and Whitby Crescent addresses 14-52 and 15- 43 included). At the end of Kowhai Road travel east to the coastline. Follow the coastline south before travelling west to the intersection of Beach Road and Commodore Parry Road (Inga Road excluded). Travel west along Commodore Parry Road to Seaview Road (Prospect Terrace and Rangitoto Terrace excluded) and travel south along Seaview Road to East Coast Road. Travel north west along East Coast Road (Stanley Avenue and Gordon Avenue excluded) before turning west along Marsh Avenue to Seine Road (addresses 20-52 and 33-69 only included). Travel north and then west along Seine Road to Forrest Hill Road. Continue south along Forrest Hill Road (1-127, 2-94 Excluded) and turn west along Tristram Avenue to Wairau Road (Hillside Road excluded). Travel north west along Wairau Road (135-399 included, odd addresses only, Diana Drive, View Road and Hogans Road excluded) and continue along Glenfield Road (579-641 included, odd addresses only, James Street, Glendhu Road and Albany Highway excluded). Travel west along Sunset Road at the intersection of Glenfield Road and Sunset Road (excluded) before travelling south along Girrahween Drive to Ellice Road. Travel east along Ellice Road before travelling north along Cheval Drive to Target Road (all addresses included). Continue east along Target Road before travelling across country to Theban Place. Travel north along Theban Place to Trias Road (all addresses included). Travel east along Trias Road (Athena Drive and off roads included, Remus Place included) to Totoravale Drive (all addresses included). Travel south along Totoravale Drive to the intersection with Sunnynook Road. Travel east along Sunnynook Road on to the Northern Motorway (SH1) and then north along the Northern Motorway (SH1) back to the starting point.*

Proof of residence within the home zone will be required.

Each year, applications for enrolment in the following year from in-zone students will be sought by a date which will be published in a daily or community newspaper circulating in the area served by the school. This will enable the board to assess the number of places which can be made available to students who live outside the home zone.

**Special Programmes**

This priority category is not applicable at this school because the school does not run a Special programme approved by the Secretary.

**Out of Zone Enrolments**

Each year the board will determine the number of places which are likely to be available in the following year for the enrolment of students who live outside the home zone. The board will publish this information by notice in a daily or community newspaper circulating in the area served by the school. The notice will indicate how applications are to be made and will specify a date by which all applications must be received.

Applications for enrolment will be processed in the following order of priority:

**First Priority** will be given to students who have been accepted for enrolment in the following special programme(s) run by the school and approved by the Secretary for Education. \*\*

**Second Priority** will be given to applicants who are siblings of current students.

**Third Priority** will be given to applicants who are siblings of former students.

**Fourth Priority** will be given to any applicant who is a child of a former student of the school.

**Fifth Priority** will be given to any applicant who is either a child of an employee of the board of the school or a child of a member of the board of the school.

**Sixth Priority** will be given to all other applicants.

If there are more applicants in the second, third, fourth, fifth, or sixth priority groups than there are places available, selection within the priority group must be by ballot conducted in accordance with instructions issued by the Secretary under Section 11G(1) of the Education Act 1989. Parents will be informed of the date of any ballot by notice in a daily or community newspaper circulating in the area served by the school.
